

For Brigitte to win Bylaws Amendments, she needs to get 2/3 or 66.67% majority.

She failed to get the 2/3 majority at Local 30 poll location, where workers at the following workplaces have rejected her proposed dictatorial control. (43% of the members rejected the proposed Bylaws change.)

At the La Costa and Pala poll locations, her win was achieved because of election violations.

Almost all of the 70 uncounted challenged ballots are from opponents to the proposed amendments working in SDCC and banquet elsewhere. Since the Local 30 office wasn't open, they all were deprived of their opportunity to adjust their status back to "Active" and their right to cast the "no" votes. 38 additional "no" votes would reduce the percentage of "yes" votes to less than 66.67% or 2/3 majority required to adopt the proposed amendments and reject her proposed dictatorial control.
